Clyde A. Taylor



A native of Brunswick, Georgia, Clyde was educated in Glynn County Public Schools and graduated from Glynn Academy. He followed in his Dad’s footsteps and attended Georgia Tech where he received a BS in Electrical Engineering and an MS in Industrial Management. While at Georgia Tech, he was a member of the Alpha Tau Omega fraternity and served as a Graduate Instructor in Economics. He met his future wife, Sue Wells, who was a student at Emory University. Clyde was a Distinguished Military Graduate of Georgia Tech and served in the US Army with the rank of Captain.

Following graduation, Clyde embarked on a corporate career which involved living in diverse places such as Milwaukee, Saint Louis, Pittsburgh, Le Roy, NY and Birmingham, AL. In Birmingham, Clyde was invited to join the Rotary Club of Alabaster, AL, where he was a member for eight years serving on the Board of Directors. 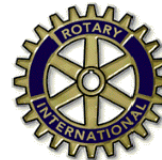
