The GRSP Conclave will be held in Rome August 28-30. The conclave is an annual kickoff event for the Georgia Rotary Student Program. It allows students and Rotarians the opportunity to meet and learn about one another as they begin an exciting year together. Roughly 75 students from 40 countries will attend Conclave 2009.

The Conclave begins with student registration on Friday mid-day and ends Sunday morning with students returning with their host families to their residences throughout Georgia. 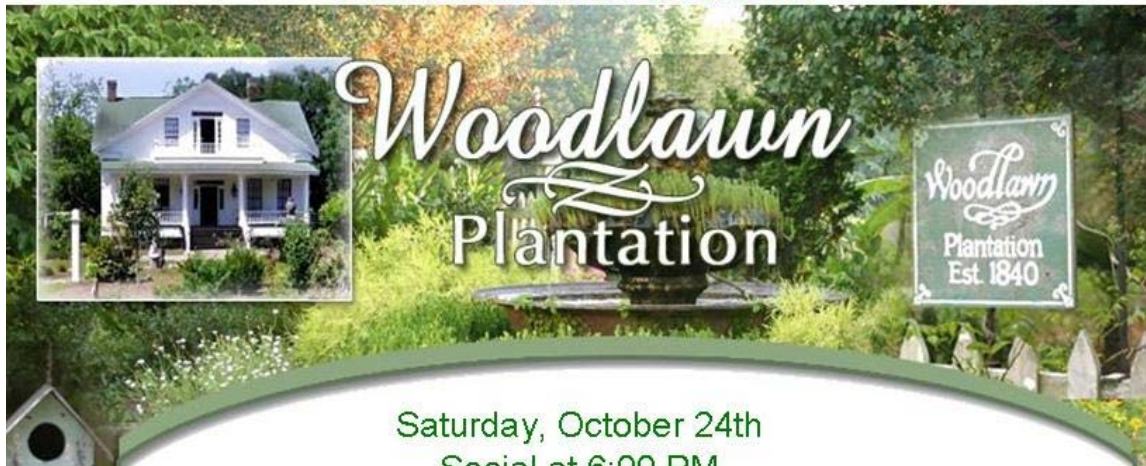

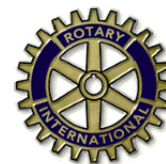
